Did You Know? Ernest Borgnine

Borgnine joined the United States Navy in October 1935, He served aboard the Destroyer/destroyer minesweeper USS Lambertson (DD-119; AG-21 and DMS-2) and was honorably discharged from the Navy in October 1941.

In January 1942, he reenlisted in the Navy after the attack on Pearl Harbor. During the war, he patrolled the Atlantic Coast on an antisubmarine warfare ship, the USS Sylph (PY-12). In September 1945, he was honorably discharged from the Navy. He served a total of almost ten years in the Navy and obtained the rank of gunner's mate 1st class.

Borgnine's military awards include the Navy Good Conduct Medal, American Defense Service Medal with Fleet Clasp, American Campaign Medal with bronze star, and the World War II Victory Medal.
